**Tracks** – Department/Program track participants will walk away with a start-to-finish assessment plan designed to measure student learning outcomes and/or other programmatic outcomes while participants in the Divisional track will walk away with keys for developing a division-wide assessment plan for their own campuses. Community College track is for anyone looking to develop assessment skills and an assessment plan within the two year college setting.
